Knowledge

Our focus for the knowledge sessions this half term is 'The sea'. We will begin by looking at what can be found in the ocean and identify lots of animals. We will consider what we might see at the beach. We will learn about what can harm life under the sea as well as why lighthouses are important. To finish we will look at what stories people have told about the sea and how we can stay safe near the sea. We will compliment our learning with our trip to the Sealife centre.

Maths

We will start by learning the days of the week and months of the year. We will then review the core skills we have learnt this year. Lastly we will learn about positional language, 2d and 3d shapes and patterns.

Music

We will continue to listen and respond to music in particular music from composers such as Holst, Rimsky-Korsakov and Tchaikovsky. We will then revise all the songs we have learnt this year such as 'Five little ducks', 'I'm a little teapot' and 'Big Bear Funk'.



Art & DT

We will create pieces of art inspired by artists such as Patrick Heron and Derek Gores and individual art related to our sea theme such as octopus and fish.

To begin with we will be learning about our bodies and how to respect our bodies; such as eating healthy. We will then be talking about what the children are looking forward to in Year 1 and any worries they may have. To finish we will be celebrating all of the children's achievements in Reception.
